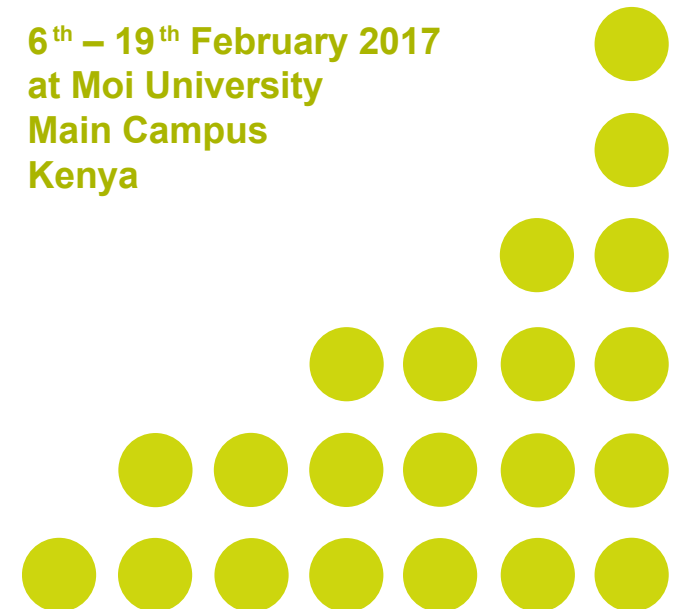

CERM-ESA is a joint project between the Moi University (Kenya), University of Oldenburg (Germany), Nelson Mandela Metropolitan University (South Africa), Uganda Management Institute (Uganda) and the University of Dar es Salaam (Tanzania) and is funded by the German Academic Exchange Service (DAAD) with funds from the German Federal Foreign Office.
