Last submission date: 15 th of December 2021	 Apply online for a DAAD/CERM-ESA scholarship to study for a i) PhD in Sociology of Education or a ii) Master of Education in Research at Moi University on or before the 15th December, 2021 (see details in separate document: "DAAD In-Country/In-Region Scholarship Programme" Call for Scholarship Applications 2022)
	 Please ask CERM-ESA at Moi University (cermesa@mu.ac.ke) to issue a cover letter for you to upload to the DAAD portal ('admission letter of host university') without payment to make your application documents complete Please check the Moi University admission requirements carefully before applying to DAAD (see below) since the final awarding of the scholarship will depend on whether you are admitted to the respective Master's / PhD programme at Moi University
STEP 2 February / March 2022	 If you are shortlisted in STEP 1, you will be notified by end of February regarding the next step, which will be an interview (face- to-face or online) and a joint CERM-ESA / DAAD final selection meeting in March or April 2022 If you come out successful in STEP 2, you will be awarded a PhD / Master's scholarship on the condition that you are admitted at Moi University. In order to be admitted at Moi University, please follow the procedure described below. The CERM-ESA office will provide support during this phase.
1 st September 2022	- Start of the scholarship and the study programme at Moi University

Application Procedure to be admitted at Moi University (only for successful candidates of STEP 2)

CERM-ESA will provide you with the introductory letter needed while applying for the certificate.

Programme requirements:

I) Master of Education in Research

University Admission Requirements

A student for the Masters of Education in Research in the Department of Educational Management and Policy Studies must:

i) Be a holder of at least a Bachelors degree of Second Class Upper in Education from a recognized institution of higher learning.

ii) May in addition to documentary evidence for eligibility for registration, be required to appear for an interview by CERM-ESA Steering Committee.

Duration of the Programme

The programme shall normally take a period of two (2) academic years. An academic year shall normally consist of two Semesters each lasting fourteen weeks.

Mode of Delivery of the Programme

Multiple perspectives to teaching and learning will be adopted. The following approaches will be used: Lectures; tutorials and seminars; practical classes; demonstrations; self-directed learning and E-Learning.

Student Assessment and Examination Procedures

Examination and Thesis will be evaluated as per the guidelines in university regulations (for examination, theses and desertions). The first year of the course will be spend on course work, colloquium and development of research proposal. The second year will be used for research to be reported in the form of a thesis.

II) Doctor of Philosophy in Sociology of Education

University Admission Criteria

To qualify for admission into the Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D.) Programme in Sociology of Education, the applicant must fulfill the academic requirements as prescribed by Moi University Senate.

a) Shall be a:

(i) Holder of a Master's degree of Moi University in Sociology of Education or its equivalent(s) OR

(ii) Holder of a relevant Master's degree of any other university recognized by Moi University Senate OR

(iii) Holder of other qualifications considered by Moi University Senate as equivalent to a relevant Master's degree

b) Shall in addition to the Master's degree, normally have an undergraduate Bachelor's degree

d) May in addition to documentary evidence for eligibility for registration, be required to appear for an interview by CERM-ESA Steering Committee.
